An emergency meeting of the President and Board of Trustees was held at 8:30 a.m., June 25, 2013, at the Village Hall, 1202 4th Street, Orion, Henry, Illinois. The following members were present: Cooper, Peterson, O'Leary, Mitton, and Drucker. Absent: Newman and Lawson.

President Cooper called the meeting to order. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss procedures for clean up after a June 24th late afternoon storm caused a swath of wind damage to trees in the village. Employees Chris Lundburg, Neil Dahl, Arnie Sandberg, and Sandy Mizen were present at the meeting.

Public works employees were instructed to pick up landscape waste debris caused by the storm. The landscape waste site was opened for any resident wanting to haul debris to the site. The site will not be available for commercial enterprises. Street Supt. Neil Dahl asked that debris be placed at the curb in neat bundles and of a size that the village's equipment could handle. He asked that small twigs and debris be bagged for pick up. Anything cut into firewood size will be picked up last.

No debris other than landscape waste will be accepted at the village's site or picked up by village employees. If the landscape waste site becomes overloaded it will be closed until debris can be burned down.

There being no further business to come before the board, President Cooper adjourned the meeting.
